

## FRONT MOUNT SPOTLIGHT/LED LIGHT BAR MOUNTING BRACKETS FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

(1 x PAIR)



### TLRFMSLB – FRONT MOUNT SPOT/LED LIGHT BRACKETS fitted to front of Flat Top Tracklander Roof Rack.

The **TRACKLANDER – FRONT MOUNT SPOTLIGHT/LED LIGHT BAR MOUNTING BRACKETS (TLRFMSLB)** are designed to provide strong adjustable mounting points, on which Individual Driving Lights or LED Light Bars (up to 1000mm wide) can be safely and securely fitted. The **TLRFMSLB** are mounted to the Channel Section underside, front of any Tracklander Roof Rack of this build. This allows for full width adjustment and 20mm vertical height adjustment to suit all types of Driving Lights.

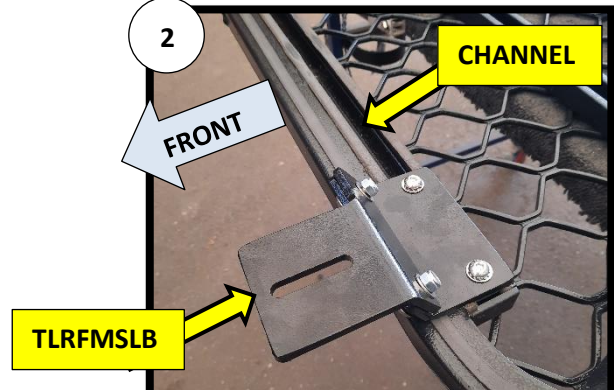
The **TLRFMSLB** (Front Mount Spotlight/LED Light Bar Bracket) is made from Aluminium, Powder Coated Ripple Black and secured with Stainless Steel Fasteners. There is Foam Tape on the surfaces that contact the Roof Rack Channel, to prevent vibration and coating damage.

With Roof Rack upside down, remove existing Wind Deflector. (if one is fitted)

Fit and fasten TLRFMSLB to the open side of Channel and tighten firmly, at the required distance apart.

WIDTH & HEIGHT

With Roof Rack fitted to vehicle, adjust height of Bracket to suit Lights and rooftop clearance. Tighten Fasteners firmly.

The TLRFMSLB are now ready for the Driving Lights or LED Light Bar to be mounted.

**NOTE: Check local Vehicle Driving Light regulations.**

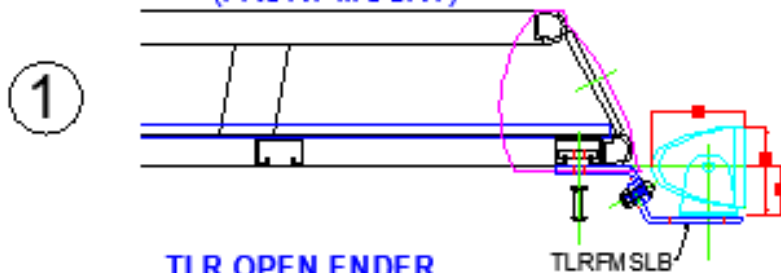

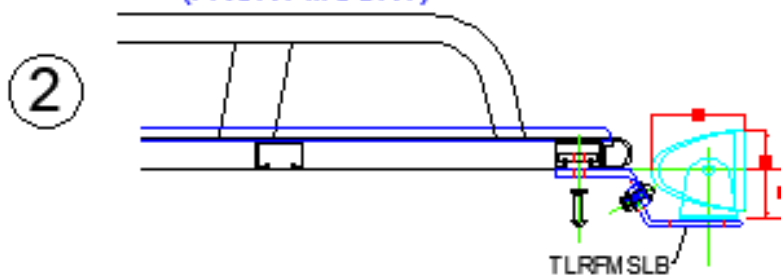
### TLR FRONT MOUNT SPOTLIGHT BRACKET FITTING OPTION DIAGRAMS for Spot Lights and LED Light Bars

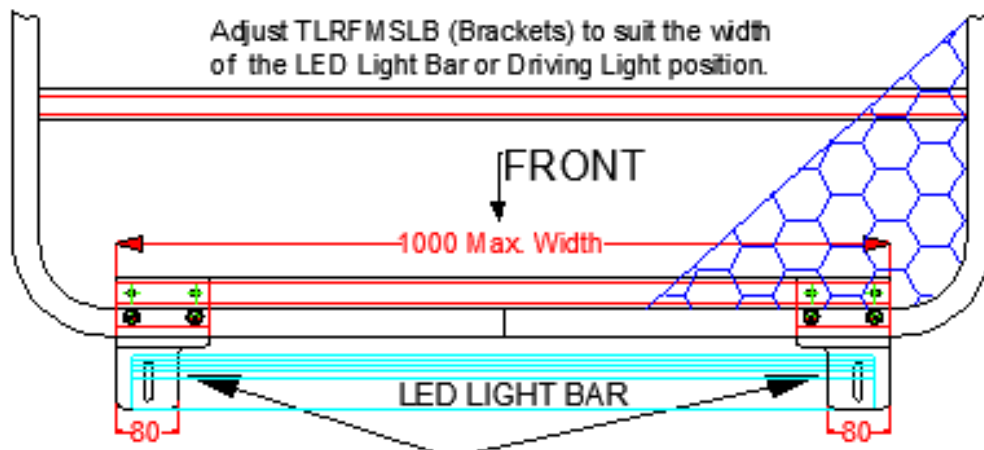
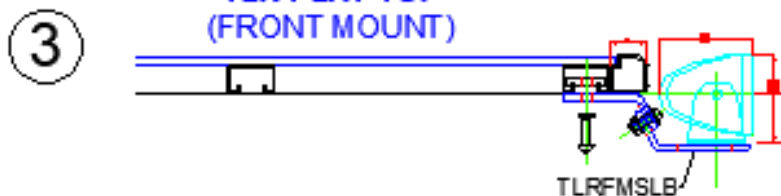
#### TLR ENCLOSED TOP (FRONT MOUNT)
